Celebrating 125 Years

Pahquioque Rod & Gun Club was organized in 1899 in Danbury Connecticut. A storied history where shooters arrived by horse and buggy, spending the day shooting and picnicking on grassy knolls. It all started when two brothers in Redding Connecticut invited several sportsmen to their home for a clay pigeon shoot. A few weeks later 25 shooters were invited to a combination clambake and trap shoot at Tamarack Woods in Danbury and the location became the first home of the club when it was formed that same year with a total of 30 members.

The club began to host the largest and most successful trap shoots in the east and attracted some of the top shooters in the country with the likes of Ad Topperwein of Texas and Rollo Heikes from Ohio (first winner of the Grand American). Pahquioque hosted many notable shooters over the years - Annie Oakley, John Phillips Souza and baseball greats Babe Ruth, Lou Gehrig, Bill Dickey and Christy Mathewson, to name a few.

Remington Arms factory and headquarters in Connecticut were represented by Cliff and son Dick Baldwin, longtime members of Pahquioque. Dick Baldwin served as Museum Director for the Trapshooting Hall of Fame located then in Vandalia Ohio. He was "the" historian on the game of trap and his stories from the old days were priceless. His historical writing is captured in his book "The Road to Yesterday". Pahquioque also boasts two of its very own as members of the ATA Hall of Fame - M.D. Clark and Dick Baldwin.

Danbury was known as the "Hat Capital of the World" and winning a coveted stylish hat in competition was a big draw. A tradition that started as early as 1911. In the late 1920s a special train was chartered to bring shooters from NYC to the "Hat Shoot". The M.D. Clark/Hat Shoot held each year in August is the longest running one-day registered shoot in the United States. It is said that club member M.D. Clark was the fastest doubles shooter to stand on the line with a Model 12. Clark achieved multiple Connecticut State champion titles.





Pahquioque and its members were instrumental in influencing the state fish and game regulators to adopt tough rules to protect native fish and game and to work to restore vanishing populations of native wildlife. The club was also a force in fostering interest in and the growth of trapshooting in Connecticut and nearby states. Continuing to this day, Pahquioque offers free comprehensive safety and trapshooting orientations to new shooters every Tuesday at the club's current home grounds in Wooster Mountain State Park in Danbury.

Come experience the history by joining us every Tuesday for a fun round of trap or a challenging go at our newly installed 5-stand field. And if you would like to help celebrate our 125th Anniversary, speak to any member about pre-squadding for our 2-day registered shoot to be held on June 1-2.

NOTICE TO ALL PERSONS ON THE GROUNDS OF THE CONNECTICUT TRAPSHOOTING ASSOCIATION AND THE HARTFORD GUN CLUB

It is the policy of the Connecticut Trapshooting Association (hereafter referred to as CTA), to adhere strictly to all state and federal firearms laws and regulations and to require the same of anyone on the premises of the CTA or the Hartford Gun Club (hereafter referred to as HGC).

No person who is disabled by federal or state law from the possession of a firearm, including the frame or receiver of any such weapon, shall possess any firearm, or the frame or receiver of any such weapon, on the grounds of the CTA or the HGC. Any such person found to be in violation of this rule shall be immediately reported to the police.

Any person who facilitates or enables the possession of a firearm, or the frame or receiver of any such weapon, by a person who is otherwise disabled by state or federal law to be in possession of a firearm, or the frame or receiver of any such weapon, shall be immediately reported to the police.

Any person who shall violate this policy of the CTA shall be disqualified from participating in any shooting event and shall

otherwise be precluded from discharging a firearm on the grounds of the CTA or HGC and such person shall forfeit any fees paid for targets or options and any prizes or purses.

Any person who, in violation of this policy, shall participate in any event in which the winner shall be entitled to a firearm, including the frame or receiver of any such weapon, shall be disqualified from receiving such firearm, including the frame or receiver of any such weapon, its cash equivalency, or any other award or prize and shall forfeit any entry fees or other monies paid to the CTA for participation in the event.

Any firearm, or the frame or receiver of any such weapon that is forfeited by a participant in any such event for violation of this policy, shall be awarded to the next eligible participant. If there shall be more than one eligible participant, such persons shall shoot-off to determine the winner under such rules as shall be promulgated by the CTA.

The interpretation and application of this policy shall reside exclusively with the CTA and any person who is on the premises of the CTA or the HGC consents to any determinations made under this policy by the CTA, all of whose decisions are final.

General Information 2024 Connecticut State Shoot

TO ALL TRAP SHOOTING COMPETITORS:

The purchase of ammunition in the state of Connecticut requires the purchaser to possess a current Connecticut Pistol Permit OR Connecticut Ammunition Purchase Certificate. If you do not have either a permit or certificate we strongly suggest that you bring ammunition with you for all events you plan to shoot.

Each Singles and Handicap event will be shot on a 5 bank system. Two traps per bank, 50 targets per field, 5 targets per post. (Modified 50). It is **MANDATORY** that shooters bring 50 shells to their starting post.

EMPTY SHELLS: If you want your empties put them in your pocket. You may not pick up your or anyone else's empty shells once they hit the ground. Once shells hit the ground they become the property of the CTA and may not be removed by anyone not authorized to do so.

Doubles events will be shot on a 10 bank system with every trap being a starting trap. 25 pair in two sub-events on the same trap.

Squads will be limited on Friday to 40-40-30 for Singles, Handicap and Doubles, on Saturday to 60 and to 40-60 for Sunday Doubles and Handicap.

Hartford Gun Club has a good neighbor policy limiting shooting until dark.

Vendors are not permitted to sell ammunition unless specifically permitted to by a CTA officer.

Practice fields will be held on Fields 5a (house 9) and field 5b (house 10). Practice will begin 30 Minutes prior to the start of each event. The practice will close 1 hour after the start of each event.

Food trucks will be available Friday, thru Sunday

The CTA meeting will be held between events Sunday to elect our ATA Delegate, Alternate and CTA Delegates at large.

Cashiering notes: The squadding table will be open at 7:00 am on Friday/Saturday, 8:00 am on Sunday. The cashier windows will be open 8:00 am daily. You must be classified prior to cashiering.

The pay-off window will be open at 11:30 am daily. Pay-off sheets for Saturday's and Sunday's events, along with uncollected winnings will be mailed to all shooters.

It is the shooter's responsibility to make sure their score is posted correctly. Once the options are figured, there will be no changes.

All settled trophies will be available upon completion of the event. If you are unable to pickup your trophy before the end of the shoot, email Bill Morton at frankmorton278@gmail.com with your contact information. Arrangements will be made to get you any trophies you have coming and are unable to pickup.

The CTA reserves the right to refuse any entry, change or cancel all or part of the program, or adjust traps as circumstances require.

Violation of any ATA rule, may result in disqualification for the event or subsequent events at the tournament director's discretion.

If you are bringing an ATV/Golf cart, you must provide the HGC with proof of insurance and they will issue a sticker.

Shoot Management reserves the right to alter shoot-off formats to include score sheet tie breakers in all events as conditions warrant.

Classification

Cheryll Pittera, ATA Delegate, is Chairman of the Classification Committee.

Cards must be up to date and correct or shooters must shoot class AA. Shooters classification will be determined by their averages and known ability.

Early classification, squading and cashiering will be open on Thursday June 20th, from 4:00pm – 6:00pm.

Penalty

To avoid penalty classification in events, shooters must have 1000 Singles, 1000 Handicap, and 750 Doubles targets for current, and previous **year** combined or be placed in no less than A Singles and A in Doubles.

Handicap as follows:

Adult shooters will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yardage **not to exceed 25 yards.**

The following requirements are for Junior and Sub Junior:

Junior – 500 Current and previous year.

Sub Junior – 200 Current and previous year.

Target only shooters may shoot their normal classification but are prohibited from winning any trophy, money or special purse.

Senior Veterans are exempt from penalty rules.

2024 PreSquad Instructions

PreSquadding for the 2024 Connecticut State Shoot will be done on line thru www.presquad.com. A non-refundable fee of \$2.00 per post/per event will be charged. Fees are to be paid when squadding thru www.presquad.com. PreSquadding will start May 6, 2024 and conclude June 7, 2024.

All unclaimed posts will be released 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. There will be no refunds or exceptions.

Classification, Squading and Cashiering will be available Thursday, June 20th from 4:00pm to 6:00pm at the Hartford Gun Club clubhouse.

While most posts will be available on presquad.com starting on May 6th, THERE WILL BE POSTS AVAILABLE AT THE SHOOT FOR ALL EVENTS on a first-come first-served basis.
